Skills will be built through activating communication arts. We focus on the wellbeing of each girl so that she can increase confidence, develop positive self - esteem and reach her full potential. All activities take place in a supportive girl-centric environment so girls can connect with one another and the group.

WHY

To increase confidence, girls **need to practice** showing up, speaking up and stepping up. The craft of theater is the perfect medium to use creativity, while making the activities personal and

relevant so that the comfort level increases each day. After repeated exposure and opportunity for a girl to explore her voice, be comfortable with her body, in a supportive environment, the result will be increased confidence and awareness.

With increased confidence girls are willing to take initiative and continue to seek out unique opportunities which positions them to have greater options in the future and during critical developmental years.

Girls Will Learn

- Components of speech: tone, speed, pitch, volume, dictation,
- Importance of body language eye contact, facial expression, gestures, movement

- Leadership principles
- Types of speech storytelling, folktales, impromptu, informative or persuasive
- Design elements through masks, costume sketching, scene design, and/ or prop making
- Giving back to the community
- Presentation and performing*
